



Chatting about Tupperware

What you can do

- Compare the size and shapes of tubs
- Fill the tubs and shake them
- Make pretend shops
- Stack the tubs on top of one another and inside each other
- Pretend that the tubs are buildings and make a road
- Pretend that the tubs are beds and make

What you can talk about

What you are doing with the tubs: shaking, filling, emptying, stacking, building, opening, closing

What the tubs are like: round, square, rectangular, thin, tall, cylinders, cubes, transparent, opaque, open, closed, full, empty

Make believe: Create stories about the toys in the beds in hospital or the people living in the Tupperware houses on the street

Language for thinking: Compare the tubs (flattest, longest, heaviest, thinner, taller; more; less) ; Can you remember what we put in the tub; What else will fit in the tub; Why can't we put this in the tub? Which one has got more in it?
