CSH Surrey is a not-for-profit business called a social enterprise (as opposed to a 'commercial enterprise'). This means we have a social ethos and exist to benefit the local communities in which we work.

Annual leave

All our colleagues get a generous amount of paid annual holiday, depending on how long you've worked here or with the NHS. On joining you get 27 days, pro-rata, plus public bank holidays rising to 29 days after five years' service and those who have worked in the NHS for 10 years or more get 33 days.

Flexible working

We have a range of flexible working options to help you balance your home and working life including flexi-time, working from home, part-time hours and job sharing depending on service requirements.

Pension

The NHS Pension Scheme is still one of the most generous and comprehensive in the UK. When you start working for us you automatically become a member and you will get an excellent package of pension benefits.

Salary

Everyone joining the NHS is guaranteed a competitive salary that matches their ability and responsibilities. All of our salaries are subject to an annual increase and are part of Agenda for Change. We also offer a high cost area supplement.

Maternity, paternity and carer's leave

We offer paid leave to support people with families.

Training and development

We are committed to the personal development of all colleagues and offer numerous training opportunities to further training and career.

Health and wellbeing

We look after the physical and mental health of all our colleagues, with access to a range of support.
