## Who are we?

We are a specialist multi-disciplinary service that provides care for people with Motor Neurone Disease (MND). The team comprises of Speech and Language Therapists, a Dietitian, Physiotherapists, a Psychologist, the Wheelchair Service and Therapy Assistants.

## What do we do?

Together we provide treatment and support for issues such as:

- Difficulty with swallowing and communication
- Maintaining good nutrition
- Exercise and mobility
- Enabling daily activities.

We work closely with other services including:

- Occupational therapists from Social Care
- Local GPs and neurology services
- Specialist MND centres such as King's College Hospital
- Princess Alice Hospice and their therapists and specialist nurses, doctors and social workers
- The MND Association and their visitors' service
- Community nursing, including District Nurses and Community Matrons.
