

The first 5 years of your child's life are very important. Your child's healthy social-emotional development forms a foundation for lifelong learning. ASQ:SE-2 is a set of questionnaires about behaviour and social-emotional development in young children. There are nine questionnaires for different ages to assess children from 1 month to 6 years old.

ASQ:SE has been used by parents for more than 15 years. It provides a way of knowing whether a child's social-emotional development is on track. It helps you celebrate milestones while addressing any concerns as early as possible. ASQ:SE-2 can help identify your child's social-emotional strengths and areas where your child may need support.

As a parent or caregiver, you are the best source of information about your child. That's why ASQ:SE-2 is designed for *you* to complete. You will only need 10–15 minutes. It's that quick and easy. Here's how ASQ:SE-2 works:

- Answer each question by marking "often or always," "sometimes," or "rarely or never." Answer based on what you know about your child.
- Note if any behaviours concern you.
- Remember that your answers help show your child's strengths and areas where he or she may need support.
- After you finish, your child's health professional will discuss the results with you.

If your child's social-emotional development is on track, then there is nothing more you need to do. If there are concerns, then the health professional will help you with next steps. When children get support as early as possible for behavioural concerns, problem behaviour may be prevented from getting more difficult as children get older.

You play an important role in your child's learning and development. Completing ASQ:SE-2 questionnaires helps you make sure your child is off to a great start!
